- The event will be open to the public from 12.00 to 17.30 on Friday, 10.30 to 17.30 Saturday and Sunday with a possible photo charter on the Friday evening & "Early Bird" access for photographers from 8am.
- You will be able to set-up from 14.00 to 18.00 on Thursday 11 September and from 08.00 on Friday 12 September. Arrivals after 11:00 Friday and 09:30 Saturday/Sunday should be advised in advance please.

- In certain circumstances the Moseley Railway Trust may be able to provide assistance or pay some transport expenses for attending exhibits. Any such assistance or expenses must be agreed in writing with the show organisers in advance of attendance to the event.
- Only period equipment will be allowed in the main display areas during the show opening hours. Modern equipment must be removed at least 45minutes prior to show opening times.
